The applicant reported that the plans had been designed to address the key points raised on the previous withdrawn application. The architect talked members through the design. The building is not listed but has history and he reported that he had tried to representative this. He confirmed that it does have a flat roof with a slight in-dent at the back. The rear facing windows are stepped in to help ensure that they do not overlook neighbouring properties. The development is 1 ¼ metres from the boundary and does not extend as far into the garden as the previous design. The applicant believes that they have addressed all material objections. S Ramus reported that near neighbours have no objections.
