Purchase of the exclusive right of burial in a grave for one person for a term of 99 years from the date of burial and interment of Great Wilbraham resident <sup>†</sup>	£275
Purchase of the exclusive right of burial in a double depth grave for a term of 99 years from the date of burial and first interment of Great Wilbraham resident <sup>†</sup>	£275
Interment fee for any subsequent opening	£110
Purchase exclusive right of burial in a grave for one person for a term of 99 years from the date of burial for stillborn or child under 2 years	£0
Purchase exclusive right of burial in a grave for one person for a term of 99 years from the date of burial for child under 12 years	£110
Purchase of ashes plot and first interment of Great Wilbraham resident <sup>+</sup>	£137.50
Scattering of ashes in Memorial Garden	£44
<sup>†</sup> For anyone not classified as a Great Wilbraham resident but has a proveable connection with the village.	Double fee
For casket shaped grave	Additional £55

+ A Great Wilbraham resident for these purposes is a person who was domicile in the parish of Great Wilbraham either: -

1. Immediately before his/her death; or
2. When the exclusive right of burial was purchased, if at an earlier date; or
3. Until he/she left the parish for care in his/her declining years; or
4. In the case of a still-born child, if either or both parents are domicile in the parish at the time of interment.

An application may be made to the Parish Council to consider an individual case.

For the grant of right to erect and maintain a headstone (see terms and conditions) for a term of 20 years.	£55
For the right to place a flat tablet flush with the surface of ground (see terms and conditions)	£33
For the right to place on any headstone of tablet additional inscription after the first	£22
For the right to place a plaque on a bench for 20 years	£22
