CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, GREAT WILBRAHAM & LITTLE WILBRAHAM) (SPEED LIMITS) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 20--

The Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82, 83, 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, having given public notice in accordance with subsection (2) of that section and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 9 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "Cambridgeshire County Council (Various Roads, Great Wilbraham & Little Wilbraham) (Speed Limits) Consolidation Order 20--" and shall come into operation on the - day of - 20--.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any of the roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule and which is indicated by way of the map-based schedule and map schedule legend as being a road or part thereof subject to a 20 mph speed limit to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on any of the roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule and which is indicated by way of the map-based schedule and map schedule legend as being a road or part thereof subject to a 30 mph speed limit to this Order.
- 4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on any of the roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule and which is indicated by way of the map-based schedule and map schedule legend as being a road or part thereof subject to a 40 mph speed limit to this Order.
- 5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 6. The following Orders are hereby revoked:
